ACEDC presented their annual update with 2025 goals.

Department Head reports: EMA – Finalizing the 2025 Emergency Management Budget and preparing for presentation to the Emergency Management Commission. Submitted three grant applications: acquisition of a drone for emergency response, radios to improve communication for first responders, and additional pagers for first responders in Adams County. Created and launched a new social media page on Facebook for the Community Outreach Initiatives. Emergency notifications will also be shared on this platform. Doing research for the LEPC Local Emergency Planning Committee. Maintenance – Annual boiler inspection passed with one note of installing a CO2 detector which has been completed. Resolved ignition issues by cleaning the ignitor. Cleared all leaves from premises, repaired the register in the jury room, and replaced three 500W courtroom light bulbs. These bulbs are increasingly difficult to source. Mike Dasher recommends considering a lighting system upgrade to avoid future supply issues. Auditor – Attending a meeting with Senator Shipley and Senator Dawson tomorrow regarding HF718 and the effects it has had on Adams County. Then attending a meeting with ISAC software Task force on Wednesday. We have our software fixed through September's month end. Working on GAAP report and valuations.
