

Board Minutes January 6, 2025

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, January 6, 2024, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Scott Akin, Leland Shipley, Tony Hardisty, and Chris Standley. Bobbi Maynes was absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Hardisty at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Standley to approve the agenda and the minutes of the January 2nd meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Akin moved, seconded by Standley to include amounts of ARPA funds (\$469,335.85) since the board received the final purchase price on the motor grater in the amount of \$369,990. The remaining funds are allocated to the Historic Widener Building Revitalization Project for \$75,000, and Adams County Conservation for \$24,345.85. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Secondary Roads Update – Prepared for a snowstorm yesterday but one did not manifest. Have been cleaning trucks. Looking into renting a skid loader.

Akin moved, seconded by Shipley to appoint Dr. Steven Freeman to a one-year term as Adams County Medical Examiner. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Appointment of Assistant Medical Examiner was tabled.

Appointment to the Zoning Board of Adjustment was tabled.

Appointment to the Condemnation Board was tabled.

Tabled action on MOU for Mental Health Advocate.

Tabled action on the courthouse lighting.

Budget request was made by the Sheriff's Department.

Department Head reports: Sheriff – Plans to put the truck for sale on Purple Wave. Auditor – Mailing W-2's.

Akin moved, seconded by Standley to adjourn the meeting at 9:45 AM. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.
