Preservation room update: the preservation room at the Courthouse now has furnishings and cabinets for storage placed in the room.

Discussed including the House of history, Opera House, etc. on a tour and possibly involve high school students who are interested. Dates of the mobile museum are October 14th to the 19th 2025.

Cemetery workshop dates: The Mount Pleasant Cemetery has been cleaned off. The dates of September 27th, October 4th, and October 11th, were discussed to hold the workshop. Saundra will contact Dennis Allen to see if he is available for any of these dates.

Other business: A gift basket for Cindy Nagle's, Tallgrass Archaeology, birthday will be given to Cindy when she attends our meeting next month.
