The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, January 2, 2026, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Scott Akin, Leland Shipley, Chris Standley, Tony Hardisty, and Bobbi Maynes. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Standley at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Hardisty to approve the agenda and the minutes of the January 2nd meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. There were no public comments.
