Maynes moved, seconded by Hardisty to approve Liquor License LC0049294 BROTHERS HUSTLING LLC. Floating Vine. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Maynes moved, seconded by Akin to approve audiometric exams for employees and the quote from Onsite Medical Service, Inc, for \$1,200. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

County Attorney Knuth will investigate case law along with code section 225c.61 to see if it applies to burial assistance in Chapter 6 – General Assistance.

Discussion was held regarding Appointment of Assistant Medical Examiner and possibility of a new doctor but waiting until next year to discuss this appointment.

Appointment of Board of Health position was tabled.

Appointment of Adams County Certified Local Government Commission position has been tabled.
