

Board Minutes February 9, 2026

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, February 9, 2026, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Scott Akin, Chris Standley, Leland Shipley, Tony Hardisty and Bobbi Maynes. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Standley at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Maynes to approve the agenda and the minutes of the February 2nd meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. Public comments were received.

Secondary Roads Update – Hearing tests are this morning. Effective March 1, the cost of rock is going up 7%. Have been hauling stockpile rock and the mechanic has been busy. Building up driveways for spring. Prescott 24 is making progress. Gathering Urban Renewal information.

Hardisty moved, seconded by Maynes to approve Adams County Dust Control Policy. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Akin moved, seconded by Shipley to approve Utility Permit 26-01 – Farmers Mutual Telephone Company. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the 28E agreement with Adams Community Economic Development Corporation. Reiterating there will be no additional cost to the county. Hardisty moved, seconded by Shipley, to approve the 28E Agreement between Adams Community Economic Development Corp. and Adams County, Iowa. Ayes: Hardisty, Shipley, Maynes, Standley. Akin sustained. Motion carried.

County Attorney Knuth recommend using Adair County’s example including documents to be provided and residency versus settlement language. He will propose an amendment to Ordinance Chapter 6, General Assistance, burial assistance portion.

Sheriff Johannes presented quotes for two mini splits for the Sheriff’s department. Shipley moved, seconded by Maynes to approve RJ’s Plumbing and Heating quote of \$11,898,09. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.
