Shipley moved, seconded by Akin to approve of Soil and Water Commission Inspection Reports. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Department heads reports: Veterans Affairs – Taylor County is still considering a 28E agreement for their director. Auditor – Attending SOS Election Tabletop Exercises with IT and EMA. Working on Ag Land and Family Farm credit claims. Sheriff – Plan to pick up the new Durango this week. Will be obtaining bids for another vehicle and have a price sheet for tasers. Conservation – Secondary Roads will assist with remaining docks and have been delivering rock. Lake water level is still about one to one and one-half feet below normal. Beach concrete project in progress. Kiefer Power will replace pedestals with 20, 30 and 50 amp. Water facilities will be open April 15. Jeff and Tina Russell plan to run the marina.
