

Board Minutes April 20, 2026

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, April 20, 2026, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Scott Akin, Leland Shipley, Bobbi Maynes, Chris Standley and Tony Hardisty. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Standley at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Maynes to approve the agenda and the minutes of the April 13th meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. There were no public comments.

Akin moved, seconded by Maynes to approve the Secondary Roads 5 Year program as presented by Assistant Engineer Brehm. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on Ambulance Management Services Agreement with County Attorney Knuth.

Chair called for a recess at 9:40. Came back from recess at 10:00 am.

Hardisty moved, seconded by Shipley to approve opening the public hearing for the Proposed FY 26/27 Budget at 10:00 am. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. No written comments were presented. Questions were expressed regarding what service area different items were included in. Akin moved, seconded by Shipley to close the public hearing for the Proposed FY 26/27 Budget at 10:11 am. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-21

APPROVAL OF BUDGET AND CERTIFICATION OF TAXES

AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR FY 26/27

WHEREAS, IA Code 331.434(5) requires that after a budget hearing, the Adams County Board of Supervisors shall adopt by resolution a budget and certificate of taxes, and;

WHEREAS, the Adams County Board of Supervisors has met the budget publication requirements in IA Code 331.434(3) through publication in the Adams County Free Press on 4/9/2026, and;

WHEREAS, the Adams County Board of Supervisors has met the budget hearing requirements in IA Code 331.434(3) and 331.434(4) through the public hearing held on 4/20/2025 at 10:00 A.M.;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on the 20th day of April 2026, that the Adams County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts by resolution the attached Adoption of Budget and Certification of Taxes for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2027.

WHEREAS, it is desired to make appropriations for each of the different officers and departments for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, in accordance with Section 331.434, Subsection 6, of the Code of Iowa,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Adams County Board of Supervisors, Adams County Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The amounts itemized by fund and by department or office on the attached schedule are hereby 100% appropriated from the resources of each fund so itemized, to the department or office listed in the first column on the same line of the attached schedule.

Section 2. Subject to the provisions of other county procedures and regulations, and applicable state law, the appropriations authorized under Section 1 shall constitute authorization for the department or officer listed to make expenditures or incur obligations from the itemized fund, effective July 1, 2026.

Section 3. In accordance with section 331.437, Code of Iowa, no department or officer shall expend any money or incur any liability or enter into any purpose in excess of the amounts appropriated pursuant to this resolution.

Section 4. If at any time during the FY26/27 budget year, the auditor shall ascertain that the available resources of a fund for that year will be less than said fund's total appropriations, he/she shall immediately so inform the board and recommend appropriate corrective action.

Section 5. The auditor shall establish separate accounts for the appropriations authorized in section 1, each of which account shall indicate the amount of the appropriation, the amounts charged thereto, and the unencumbered balance. The auditor shall report the status of such accounts to the applicable departments and officers monthly during the FY26/27 budget year.

Section 6. All appropriations authorized pursuant to this resolution lapse at the close of business, June 30, 2027.

Maynes moved, seconded by Hardisty to approve Resolution 2026-21 approving FY26/27 Budget with 100% Appropriations. Ayes: Maynes, Akin, Shipley, Hardisty, Standley. Nays: none. Motion carried. The original resolution is on file in the Auditor's office.

Secondary Roads Update – Working on the south pier of Lincoln 3. DOT stopped on Tuesday to talk about safety action plan. Plan to use tank cars for Nodaway 8 and Colony 15 and survey Grant 7 and 8. RJ's Plumbing will run a new sewer line for \$4,400 and Secondary Roads will do the digging.

Department heads reports: Auditor – Working on Amendment No. 2 documents. Received our primary election ballots. Will have a registration drive and mock election at SWV High School on Wednesday. Continue to certify budgets. Sheriff – Started installing the air conditioning unit. Successful K9 deployment last week. Have been busy and receiving a lot of calls. Working on taser quotes and looking at refurbished ones with warranties.

Committee and Meeting Reports: Maynes – ISAC Legislative update, April 17, Webinar; Shipley – Main Street, April 15, Corning; Hardisty –SCI 911, April 17, Creston; Akin – ACEDC, April 16, Corning.

Akin moved, seconded by Hardisty to adjourn the meeting at 10:16 AM. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.
