

Board Minutes May 18, 2026

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, May 18, 2026, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Scott Akin, Leland Shipley, Chris Standley and Tony Hardisty. Bobbi Maynes was absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Standley at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Hardisty to approve the agenda and the minutes of the May 11th meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. Public comments were received.

Secondary Roads Update – Installing road culverts and hauling rock. Cleared trees that fell across roads after Friday's storms. Hungry Canyon approved grants in the amount of \$57,126.40 for Juniper drop in let and \$17,872.37 for 170th Street.

Prescott 10 project needs to be moved into FY 2027 which increases the original amount from \$800,000 \$1.3 million. This is so it can be let in September. Hardisty moved, seconded by Shipley to approve FY 2027 Construction Program Revision. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Jayne Templeton and Tysen Christensen informed the board that there would be a 6% increase in costs for the county dental plan and a 0% increase in the cost of the life insurance plan which are both provided by Principal. Akin moved, seconded by Hardisty to accept the quotes are presented. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Jan Norris presented updated information on CO2 pipeline.

Shipley moved, seconded by Akin to approve purchasing a 2026 Ford F150 police responder from Stivers Ford for \$49,900. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Shipley moved, seconded by Akin to approve Adams County AI Policy. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding Ambulance Management Services Agreement. Plan to have a joint meeting with Ambulance and CHI Health Corning.

Hardisty moved, seconded by Shipley to approve creating a resolution with the Data Center moratorium draft information. Ayes: Hardisty, Shipley, Standley. Nays: Akin. Absent: Maynes. Motion carried.

Shipley moved, seconded by Hardisty to approve Liquor License LF0000576 Williamson American Legion Post #719. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Department heads reports: IT – The newest deputy vehicle is fully functional. Also have access to accounts to set up vehicles in the future. Auditor – Continue primary election preparations and absentee voting Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm at the Auditor's office.

Committee and Meeting Reports: Standley – DECAT, May 15, via phone call; Akin – ACEDC, May 14, Corning.
