

Board Minutes July 13, 2026

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, July 13, 2026, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Chris Standley, Leland Shipley, Scott Akin, Bobbi Maynes, and Tony Hardisty. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Standley at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Maynes to approve the agenda and the minutes of the July 6th meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. Public comments were received.

Secondary Roads Update – Tomorrow at 7:30 is the Union 17 letting. We have had several contractors reach out looking for plans and the plan holder list. The following week, July 21st is the pavement marking letting at the DOT. We will be meeting with Denco at 10:30 today to review slip lining and grouting for several culverts. Last Thursday we completed our deck pour on Lincoln 3 with no issues of note. BNSF will be closing the rail crossing in Prescott starting the 15th and will remain closed until the 16th. A detour will be put in place. Continuing hauling rock and replacing roadway tubes. We have hired Garden & Associates to perform the Douglas 2 survey.

Akin moved, seconded by Hardisty to approve 28E agreement for the Competitive Highway Bridge Program (CHBP) Grant. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.
