

Board Minutes August 3, 2026

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, August 3, 2026, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Chris Standley, Leland Shipley, Scott Akin, Bobbi Maynes, and Tony Hardisty. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Standley at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Maynes to approve the agenda and the minutes of the July 27th and July 31st meetings. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. There were no public comments.

Secondary Roads Update – Dixon Construction finished backfilling around the abutments on Lincoln 3. Union 17 bridge is gone. The dirt crew will finish this week, and the barrel crew will move in. The crew is working on shoulders, replacing roadway culverts and blading granular roads. Working with the golf course on replacing a roadway tube. Pricing tank cars to replace bridges.

Hardisty moved, seconded by Shipley to approve purchasing a 2026 Chevrolet Tahoe pursuit vehicle from Karl Chevrolet for \$53,740.20. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Akin moved, seconded by Shipley to approve Military and Homestead applications. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Department heads reports: Conservation – Triathlon is August 27. Obtaining quotes to replace Tiber Ridge restroom. Will meet with Garden and Associates for upcoming projects. Director Paul noted that high temperatures and lack of water flow significantly degrade lake water quality. Sheriff – Received 11 deputy applications. K9 golf tournament is on August 29. First Net representative will be here on Wednesday. Auditor – Met with IWMCA last week. CPR and first aid training will be on August 12 and 17. Waiting for updates from Solutions to continue with the tax process.
