The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, August 24, 2026, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Chris Standley, Leland Shipley, Scott Akin, Bobbi Maynes, and Tony Hardisty. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Standley at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Maynes to approve the agenda and the minutes of the August 17th meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. Public comments were received.

Department heads reports: Auditor – Uploaded employee list for EAB retention and recertification election. Completed ISAC salary survey and passport annual certification. Submitted reports for Cost Allocation plan. Sheriff – have busy calls and day-to-day activity. There are trials coming up next month. Getting equipment out of the K9 vehicle and outfitting the new vehicle. Reached out to insurance regarding claim check. Conducted testing for 10 deputies, five passed. Will conduct the written test and start interviews this week. Cleaning out and detailing sheriff pickup, then post on Purple Wave. Conservation – Held the third annual triathlon. There were 113 registered and had about 100 participants. Travis thanked everyone who helped. Also hosted a boy scout group from Omaha this weekend. Campgrounds have been slow, but that is normal for this time of year. Campers are starting to register for Labor Day weekend. Full-service sites are filling up. Dove season starts September 1.
