

Board Minutes September 8, 2026

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Chris Standley, Leland Shipley, Scott Akin, and Bobbi Maynes. Tony Hardisty was absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Standley at 9:00 AM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Maynes to approve the agenda and the minutes of the August 31st meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. There were no public comments.

Secondary Roads Update – Finished pouring the culvert for Union 17. Bainbridge poured Lincoln 3's southbound lane last Wednesday and will pour the northbound lane today. The two tank cars arrived at Nodaway 8. When the crew is done cleaning roads from the recent rain, they will begin replacing the bridge. We can use Poet's dirt pile to fill in the tank cars. Dale, Blake and Carter will be attending the Iowa Streets and Roads Workshop and Conference September 22-24.

Maynes moved, seconded by Shipley to acknowledge receipt of notice of termination shared engineer 28E agreement with regret. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. The board thanked Nick Kauffman for his time and assistance to our engineering department.

Shipley moved, seconded by Akin to approve signing letter of support for Certified Local Government Grant. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Saundra Leininger and Nancy Carmichael gave a Historic Preservation Commission update including pioneer cemeteries project, Nodaway 9 and Jasper 1 bridges, America's 250th open house, and genealogy information at Corning Public Library.

Shipley moved, seconded by Maynes to approve Feldhacker sidewalk quote in the amount of \$1,565. This is to replace 70 square feet of walk and that part of the drain system on the west side of the courthouse. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Department heads reports: Auditor – Preparing for the General Election. Ballot preparation has been sent to Adkins. IMWCA audit is September 9. Gathering and sending information for annual audit on September 18. EMA – As more storms come through the area, people are noticing more damage from the June 11 storm. Zach continues to remind people to review insurance policies. Maintenance – Will schedule the sidewalk repair.
